



Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP3) Funding

Pre-Award Notice

On September 8, 2010 the City of Miramar was awarded \$2,321,827.00 in Neighborhood Stabilization Program funding by HUD, referred to as NSP 3. The City will submit its plan for the use of those funds to HUD by March 1, 2011. NSP 3 funds will not be available to the City until the plan is approved by HUD.

NSP3 requires that the City further assess its community so that funds are directed to areas where the impact of the funding is truly noticeable. The City is currently in the process of reviewing the existing strategies and market conditions and developing a proposal for the allocated NSP3 funds.

The City encourages residents, prospective buyers, real estate agents, housing professionals and all other members of the general public to provide feedback to the City regarding the NSP. The City encourages you to submit written comments on the proposed budget and plan that will be posted here in the coming weeks.
