## City of Miramar Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) Goals Fiscal Year 2010

The City of Miramar has set its Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for programs utilizing Federal Department of Transportation's funds for fiscal year 2010. The City is submitting a DBE FY 2010 annual goal of 14% to the Federal Transit Administration, Region 4. 7.7% of the goal will be met through race-neutral methods and the remaining 6.3% of the goal will be met through race-conscious methods.

The DBE goal was developed in accordance with the processes described in CFR 49 Part 26. The proposed goal, its rationale and a description of how the goal was developed are available for public inspection. The public is encouraged to review the DBE goal document and provide comments. Copies of the annual goal calculation are available for review during regular business hours for a 30-day period commencing Monday June 1, 2009 and ending Tuesday, June 30, 2009 at the Office of the City Clerk located at Miramar City Hall, 2300 Civic Center Place and the Economic Development and Revitalization Department located at 2200 Civic Center Place, Miramar, Florida. Public comments regarding the City of Miramar's 2010 DBE goal will be accepted for forty-five (45) days (ending July 15, 2009) from the date of this notice.
